

Employee Equipment Inspection – The Employee Guide

Employee Requirements:

- Employees must have the equipment they will use at work inspected **within 30 days** of the employee's first day skiing/riding for work.
- To start, Employees can have up to **two sets** of equipment certified.
- An Employee should not use equipment at work that has not been inspected after the first 30 days of work (skiing/riding).
- The bindings will be adjusted by the VRR technicians to the binding manufacturer's recommended settings.

Things you need to know:

- **Snowboard** and **telemark equipment** will be inspected by your Supervisor or Manager. **Alpine/AT skis** are tested by a rental technician
- There will be an **inventory** of replacement toe/heel pieces for many brands of boots.
- **Sticker placement** needs to be visible on the skis
- If your **gear fails**, please be respectful to the technician. They will do what they can to help/direct you.
- **Bring gear** you are using now. Remember, we need the boot that goes with each set of skis to be inspected. More gear can be brought for inspection later in the season as needed.
- **Volunteers** will not be participating in this program.
